## STATEMENT OF PHILOSOPHY

The Kentridge HS PTSA Scholarship demonstrates community appreciation for scholastic achievement and encourages further education. The scholarship is designed to pay a portion of the costs for the first academic year at a post-secondary institution.

**PROCEDURE:** Obtain an application from your school counseling office or online @ KRPTSA.org.  
**All sections must be completed for consideration.**

**DEADLINE:** Return completed applications with the proper attachments by **Friday, April 24, 2020 at 2 p.m.** to the Kentridge High School counseling office or mail to Kentridge HS PTSA Scholarship Committee at P.O Box 59806, Renton, WA 98058. **All applications must be received by April 24, 2020. No late applications will be accepted.**

**AMOUNT:** It is the intent of Kentridge PTSA Scholarship Committee to select one or more recipient(s). Each award amount may be up to \$500 made payable to the post-secondary institution upon confirmation of registration.

**NOTIFICATION:** The Kentridge PTSA Scholarship Committee will notify all recipients on or before **Friday, May 29, 2020**. Recipients may be asked to attend the Kentridge PTSA Board Meeting in June to receive their award. This award may also be presented at the senior assembly.
